"Hooley on the HudsonTM" Sponsorship Summary

We are in the process of recruiting sponsors at three levels. Platinum (\$1500), Gold (\$1000), Silver (\$500) to help cover the entertainment costs for the Hooley on the HudsonTM Irish festival being presented by the City of Kingston and the Ancient Order of Hibernians Ulster County Division 1. The event will take place in the TR Gallo Park on the lower Broadway waterfront in Kingston, NY on Sunday, September 3, 2017 from 11:30 AM until 9:00 PM. 16 years of Irish Culture.

Our festival does not charge the general public any admission fee. Our goal is to provide a high quality, low cost day of family entertainment of Irish music, dancing, and fun. Last year's festival was a great success, it was estimated that over 20,000 people attended, on a sunny Labor Day Weekend Sunday. The vendors that attended reported substantial profits.




